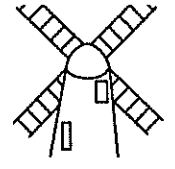

## **Year 1/2 Visit to Portsmouth Historic Dockyards – Monday 14<sup>th</sup> & Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2018**

As part of our 'Shorelines, Shanties & Secrets' topic, we would like to take the Key Stage 1 children on a visit to Portsmouth Historic Dockyards on **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> & Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2018**. While at the Dockyards, the children will have the opportunity to visit some real-life ships, explore what ship life would have been like in the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> Centuries by visiting the **HMS Warrior & HMS Victory** and will learn about the importance of the Navy and the Dockyards in the **National Museum of the Royal Navy**.

This trip will be running over 2 days, half of the year group will visit the Dockyards on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> May, the other half will visit on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> May. The classes for each day will visit the Dockyards as follows:

<b>Monday 14<sup>th</sup> May</b>	<b>Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> May</b>
1/2 S - Miss Smith's class ( <b>all children</b> )	1/2 B - Mrs Brigden's class ( <b>all children</b> )
1/2 C - Mrs Clarke's class ( <b>Year 2 only</b> )	1/2 C - Mrs Clarke's class ( <b>Year 1 only</b> )

To get to the Dockyards, Key Stage 1 children will be travelling by train, which will leave Barnham Station at around 09.20 returning at 15.10. We will aim to be back for the end of the school day but we will need to return the children to class first before letting them out onto the playground as usual, so there may be a slight delay.

On the day, school uniform will be worn with appropriate footwear for walking. Also, your child will need to bring the following **in a bag they can carry**:

- A packed lunch (a free lunch can be provided by school, please indicate below if you would like this option).
- A warm, waterproof coat.

Your child **will not** need to bring any additional money on the trip with them.

To enable us to fund this visit, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£11.00 per child** to be received by **Friday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2018**. This will cover the cost of train travel, insurance and entry to the Dockyards. If we do not receive enough contributions to cover the cost of the trip, it may not take place. Payment is to be made via our new cashless payment system so that we do not have to deal with any cash on our premises.
